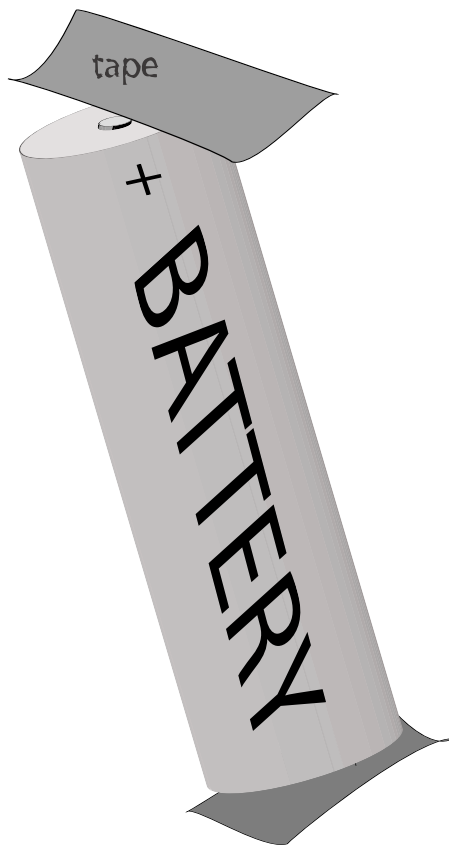




recycling batteries

Don't throw away used batteries! Battery cells contain heavy metals that can contaminate soil and ground water for a long time. So it is important to recycle batteries.



Store used batteries in a sturdy container like an empty paint can. Label the container for storing used batteries.

To prevent fire hazard caused by battery cell contacts, apply a heavy tape (like electrical tape) to each battery contact.

Post this poster or other hazardous waste information at the battery collection station.
